# Stampin' HOT FOIL SYSTEM

— QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE —



## 1 HEAT THE PLATFORM

- Place the platform on the silicone platform station.
- Plug in the power cord.



WAIT ABOUT 6 MINUTES

### DURING HEATING

White Timer Button = SOLID

Red Light = FLASHING

### PLATFORM READY

Platform beeps

White Timer Button = FLASHING

Red Light = SOLID

## 2 HEAT THE FOILING DIE

- Place the foiling die flat side down on the platform.
- Press the White Timer Button.



WAIT ABOUT 1½ MINUTES

### WHILE HEATING

Yellow Light = FLASHING

White Timer Button = SOLID

Red Light = SOLID

### FOILING DIE READY

Platform beeps

Green Light turns on

All lights are lit

## 3 BUILD YOUR SANDWICH

*Bottom → Top*

5 CLEAR HOT FOIL SPACER



4 GREEN HOT FOIL SHIM



3 CARDSTOCK



2 FOIL (Shiny side DOWN)

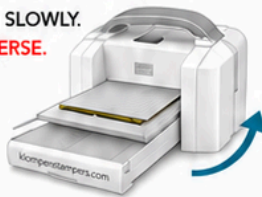


1 PLATFORM WITH DIE ON IT



## 4 FOIL YOUR PROJECT

- Unplug the platform.
- Carefully move the entire sandwich to the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
- Run it through SLOWLY.  
**DO NOT REVERSE.**



## 5 FINISH

- Place the platform back on the silicone platform station.
- Peel the foil from the cardstock.



## 6 COOL & STORE

Use the Magnetic Pick-Up Tool to move the hot die to the silicone cooling pad.



*To use again, plug back in and follow instructions. ♥*

### LIGHT GUIDE

	Flashing Red	Platform heating
	Red Solid + White Button Flashing	Platform ready
	Flashing Yellow	Foiling Die Heating
	Green On	Foiling Die ready (all lights are lit)

### ★ REMEMBER

- Foil goes **SHINY SIDE DOWN**.
- Always unplug before moving the platform.
- Run through the machine **SLOWLY**.
- Never reverse the platform through the machine.
- The platform automatically shuts off after 15 minutes of inactivity. If it does, unplug it for a few minutes, then plug it back in to restart.
